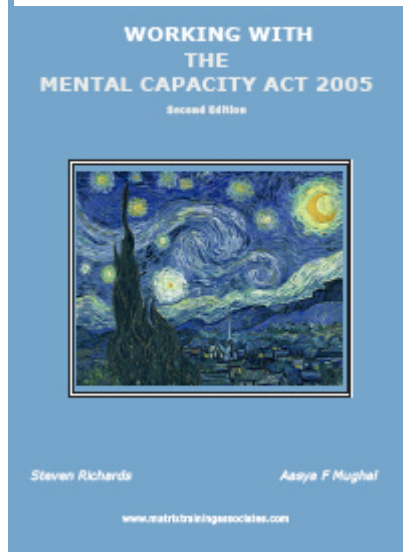


Mental Capacity Act 2005 and Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards (DOLS)
